

SORT YOUR LOAD AND SAVE

1

Separate your items at home into reusable items for the Outlook Market and non-reusable items for recycling or landfill.

2

Load your waste into your boot or trailer properly by separating items for the Outlook Market from your recyclables and general waste.

3

When you arrive, visit the Outlook Market first. The shop accepts good condition furniture, timber, building material, clothes, toys, games, tools, household fixtures and furnishings, collectables, books, CDs, DVDs and plants. Acceptance of items is subject to staff discretion.

4

Your sorted recycling will be accepted free of charge at the gate (domestic quantities).

5

Fees apply at the gate for your general waste, green waste, timber waste, building materials and other items.

Electronic waste (e-waste) is any item with a plug, battery or cord that is no longer working or wanted. This includes mobile phones, digital cameras, tablets, household appliances, power tools and electronic toys, and their accessories.

Recycling e-waste not only prevents hazardous substances leaching into soil and water, it saves valuable energy and natural resources required to make new products.
