

Statutory Declaration of Impartiality and Competence – City Valuer

In compliance with the provisions of Section 13DH(2) of the *Valuation of Land Act 1960* (as amended), the Valuer to be appointed by the City of Darebin to return the 2010 General Revaluation has made the following Declaration.
