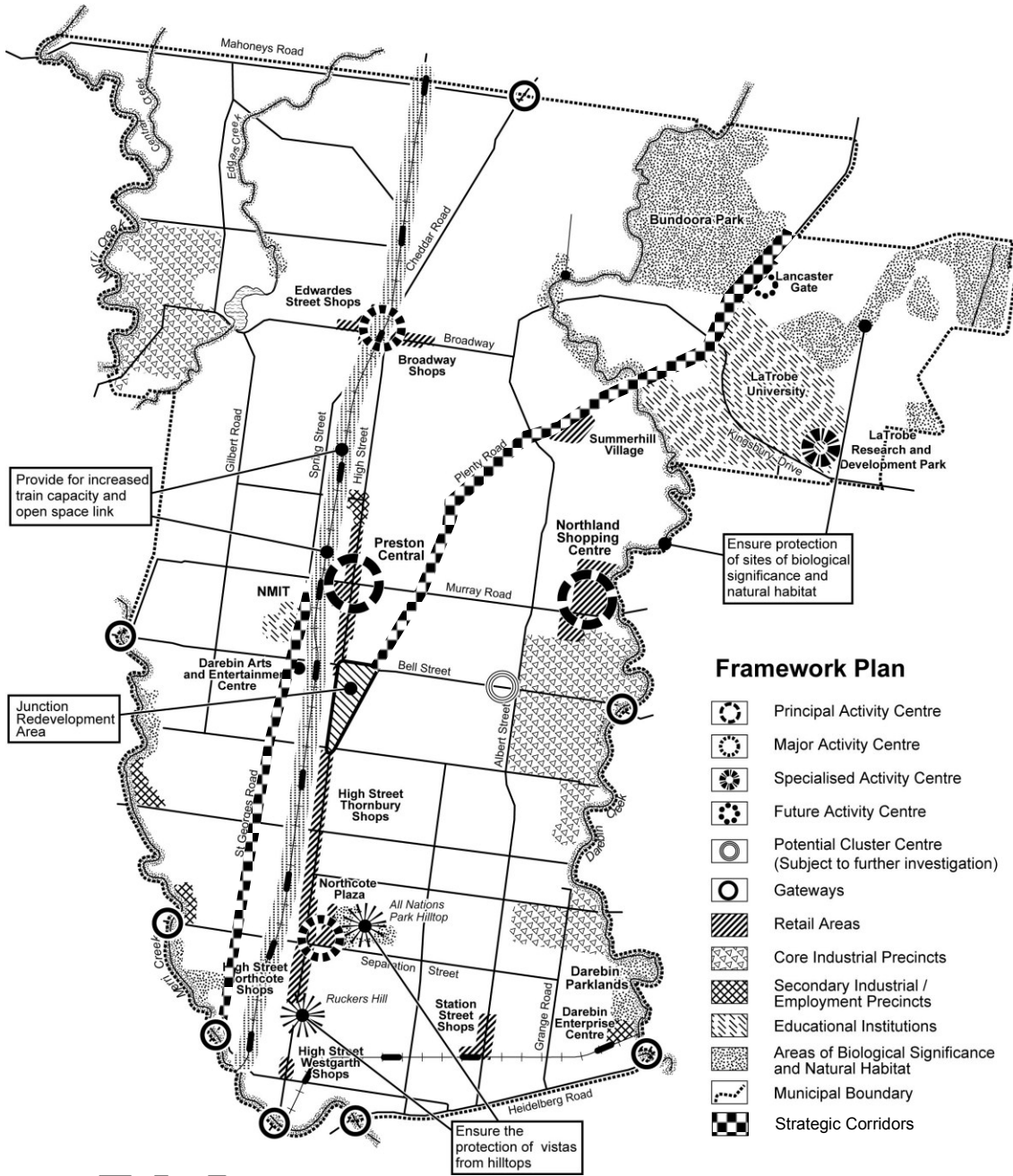
The key elements in Darebin are:
