Organisation	Organisation Description
Australian Macedonian Disability Pensioners Group "VARDAR" Inc	The group provides social, recreational and educational activities for senior members and members with a disability in the Macedonian community to meet and be supported in comfortable and familiar surroundings. Gatherings promote well-being through means of socialising and a sense of belonging to the community and reduces the feeling of isolation of our members and to maintain strong cultural connections.
Australian Thornbury Pensioners Club	The Australian Thornbury Pensioners Club was established 18 years ago. Members are all over 65 years of age and are of the Greek community of Darebin. The group meets weekly to share a meal and participate in social activities such as cards board games, dancing, craft, socialising with others, discussions and sharing ideas.
Bipolar Life Victoria	Bipolar Life Victoria is a non-profit charity governed and operated by volunteers and was founded in 2007. The group provides support services to people suffering from bipolar disorder and educational services which are focused on coping skills to help sufferers lead normal lives.
Centre of Greek Ex-Servicemen's Elderly Citizens Club of Darebin and Districts Inc	The organisation was established in 2000 to aid elderly ex-servicemen from Greek background to be active and be involved in social activities who might otherwise be socially isolated due to language barriers. The members get together every week for a meal and to engage in a variety of social activities to interact and keep them connected to the community and minimise social isolation.
Cultures together choir for Darebin	A group of older adults who create choirs and concerts for older adults in Darebin and across Victoria. The group rehearses weekly and performs at neighbourhood houses, aged care facilities and for older adults in the community and community celebrations.
Damayan Victoria Inc.	The group is mainly senior members with the aim to promote the Filipino rich culture through music, arts, interfaith, recreation and education. Members can engage in social and recreational activities to improve health and well-being and engage in community life, life long learning, environmental sustainability, facilitate innovation, acceptance of diversity and human rights that will build a resilient neighbourhoods.
Darebin Chess Club Inc	Darebin Chess Club is a community organisation whose mission is to improve residents' educational outcomes and social development by introducing them to the game of chess and promoting chess activities in the city of Darebin. These activities range from teaching and coaching programs; fostering participation in chess play both leisurely and competitively; providing the best experience for chess players at all levels and all age groups.
Darebin Presbyterian Church	A community Christmas Carols and Family Festival in Penders Park Thornbury on Saturday 10th December 2022 from 3pm - 6:30pm. Open for anyone to attend, publicised across the City of Darebin. 3-5pm: free (or very low cost) activities for families.
Fairfield Hellenic Seniors and Carers Inc	Fairfield Hellenic Seniors and Carers is group initiated by senior local women, caring for unwell and frail elderly partners. The organisation's primary objective is to continue to develop a supportive network of volunteers to meet the needs of a frailer ageing population and their carers and help them access a variety of information and activities that foster healthy living and social connection.

Friendly Senior Citizens Group	A seniors CALD group of members mostly over 80 plus a disabled members that are single and many have distant families.. The group supports reconnection with members and friends in order to start to be confident to go out again. Members meet for a meal each meeting
Friends Of Regent Community Garden	Friends of Regent Community Garden have established a space where the local community can connect, learn and participate in communal food gardening and sharing of fresh produce as well as provide sustainable activities including workshops and social events in a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment
Golden Oldies Reservoir	The Golden Oldies Club was established 27 year ago. This group of senior citizens meet twice a week to exercise, play board games and have morning tea. The group also holds 2 annual lunches each year for members to connect socially with each other while enjoying a meal while out in the community.
Greek And Cypriot Social/Welfare Centre	The centre meets on a monthly basis holding a variety of activities for our members such as guest speakers, luncheons, outings and a welfare service.
Greek Choir Parikia	The choir is made up of senior citizens from the Greek-Australian community and some other CALD communities. The group rehearses once a week and performs across Darebin and other areas of Melbourne. This choir encourages social participation and reduces isolation for our senior community members and promotes the Greek culture through music and socialising.
Hellenic Women's Federation Victoria	The Hellenic Women's Federation of Victoria is a multi-cultural organisation centred around supporting the well-being of the Darebin community. The group plans events that cater for the diversities of the community, inclusive of hospitalised people or people with special needs.
Hellenic Writers Association Australia	The association was started in 1992 as a forum for Greek Australian migrants to share their experiences in written form (poems, shorts stories, commentaries) in their mother tongue (Greek) in order to keep alive the written language and the literary tradition. The main activities involve teaching how to write literature in the Greek language (weekly 2-hour sessions), public launching of books. and the publication of the annual literary magazine 'O LOGOS' consisting of original contributions from the members.
Home Away From Home Chinese Elders Group	" Home Away From Home Chinese Elders Group" meets at the East Reservoir Senior Citizens Centre. The group meets for mutual support and wellbeing ,access to information about services, programs and activities and to learn new skills like cooking ,dancing, playing card, mah-jong, Ping -Pong game etc
Irish Australian Support and Resource Bureau INC	The Irish Australian Support and Resource Bureau is a non-profit organisation that was formed in the early 1970's by a group of community-minded people to assist those in distress. Since then the IASRB has expanded its services to include social and cultural events as well as assisting with welfare issues.
Japanese community language school in the north	The Japanese Community Language School s a non-profit community organization located in Reservoir. The classes have been held at Reservoir Neighbourhood House since 2018. Currently, 40 children attend this school every Sunday in the school term. The classes for children are run by local parents committee and teachers to help maintain and promote Japanese and Australian culture links.

Macedonian Senior Citizens Group Pelister	Every Thursday the Pelister Macedonian group gather for coffee, tea, sandwiches, and to play board/ card games. Picnics are frequently held at Yan Yean, Sorento and Geelong.
Maharishi School Ltd	Maharishi School is a small, not for profit, small independent primary school (F-6) in Reservoir, Melbourne, operating since 1997. Students have diverse cultural backgrounds with more than 20 groups represented. Maharishi School prioritises “stress free” learning and the method to achieve this is via our school’s pedagogy is its incorporation of twice daily Transcendental Meditation (“TM”) into the students' routine. The school has indigenous Scholarships and an ongoing focus to work with a nearby Indigenous kindergarten.
Melbourne Harmony Rhythm Beijing Opera Group	Melbourne Harmony Rhythm Beijing Opera Group is a not-profit organisation, aimed at providing local Chinese communities a place to enjoy and participant in traditional Beijing Opera. The organisation endeavours to promote Beijing Opera within the wider Darebin municipal area to promote cultural exchange, diversity and artistic expression.
Melbourne Polytechnic Advanced Diploma Jewellery and Object Design	The 2022 graduating class of the Advanced Diploma of Jewellery and Object Design, Melbourne Polytechnic, Fairfield Campus will provide an exhibition to support emerging artists in the community. The exhibition unites the creative community, bringing together local artists, galleries and professionals from the industry.
Multi Ethnic Senior Citizen -Preston	The group is mixture of elderly people from Bosnia and Herzegovina. They meet on a weekly basis at the Preston Library and the aim of this group is to help and prevent the isolation and loneliness of elderly people. They are involved in regular socialization and networking between people who speak the same language, are of same culture and have similar lifestyle.
Northern and Inner Multiple Birth Association (NIMBA)	The Northern Inner Multiple Birth Association (NIMBA) is run by volunteer parents who provide support, assistance and social connection to other multiples families (twins, triplets and higher order births) sharing this journey. NIMBA's activities include regular expectant parent information sessions (e.g. sleep, speech, behaviour), a monthly new parent lunch, monthly newsletter, postnatal support, breastfeeding support, linking families with other families within neighbourhood networks, a fortnightly playgroup in Thornbury, parenting information sessions, volunteer meal deliveries to families who just welcomed their babies, and social events.
Nuba Omarang Association	A Sudanese group and all of our members come from the same community - Nuba Omarang. The group meets at least twice a month with the aim of retaining cultural connections including our language. Women in the group come together to practice traditional dance.
Preston Boxing and Youth Club	The Preston Boxing and Youth Club is a youth centre aimed at physical fitness and general well-being. We are a club that has been around for over 50 years. The club welcomes young participants from all abilities and backgrounds
Preston Primary School	Preston Primary School is a vibrant Darebin public school with approximately 700 students, 60 staff, and over 1000 parents and family members. Students are from diverse ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds which provides the school with our rich cultural composition.
Probus Club of Kingsbury Inc	Encouraging lifestyle, health and wellbeing for semi-retired/retired members of the community. We provide a variety of activities including day trips, theatre outings and Guest Speakers conducive to our age group.

Reach Community Church Incorporated	Reach are planning a Community Family Fun Day with free family activities, partner with local schools and provide opportunity for students (children/youth) to contribute to the community by giving musical/creative performances - engage the community with information of activities/clubs etc in their local municipality in support of engaging children and families - improve mental & physical health, connect with others in the community.
Reservoir Chinese Seniors' Group	Members are senior citizens (60+) with some members being over 80 years old. All members are Chinese, from different areas of China. The group meets to share traditional Chinese culture and participate in activities such as singing, tai chi, cooking and tours of Melbourne.
Reservoir Combined Probus Club Inc	The Club provides Fun, Fellowship and Friendship for its Members and Guests as per the Probus Goals. Members are 55 and over, retired, semi-retired people in the community of Darebin and nearby surrounding area. The Club meets 4th Monday monthly and organises informational/fun activities such as Guest Speakers, Morning Music, Theatre, Day Trips, monthly lunches to support local venues, book club, cards/games group, etc. to promote the health and well-being of it members.
Somali Seniors Women's Group	Somali Seniors & women's Group meet weekly to increase social. mental and physical health through exercise sessions, Cultural dance, taking part in discussions on health issues and group outings and learn new skills. It will provide an opportunity for Somali women to engage in the Darebin Community
Spring Dreams Dancing group	The Spring Dreams is a Chinese dance group that meets weekly to learn and practice traditional dances. The group is made up mostly of people aged 60 and over. Many of the dances are performed at local events and aged care facilities in the community.
Strings Band Melbourne Inc.	The Strings Band Melbourne has recently been established with mostly older Chinese citizens from the Darebin community who come together twice a month to rehearse classical music in an Orchestra. The band has 20 members and perform throughout the year at local community events and venues for local members of Darebin.
Sylvester Hive	Sylvester Hive is a joint collaboration between City of Darebin Council, the Pavilion School and Darebin residents supporting urban permaculture and public open space. Its purpose is to bring the community members and neighbours together to experience gardening, share food, gardening in general including planting and harvesting of vegetables & fruit, food preparation techniques and related knowledge.
U3A Darebin Inc.	U3A Darebin provides lifelong learning, creativity, intellectual stimulation, physical wellbeing and social connection for seniors who are over 50 and no longer in full time paid employment. 2021 was the 30th anniversary of U3A Darebin and the organisation was unable to celebrate this milestone due to Covid lockdowns and social distancing rules it hopes to run some revitalising activities for the organisation in 2022-23.
Wayra Muru Dance Troupe	Wayra Muru is a dance group formed in 2021 dedicated to sharing folk traditions of the Indigenous communities of the Andean plateau (northern Chile and Argentina, southern Peru, and western Bolivia). Wayra Muru means seeds of the wind in the Quechua language - seeds dispersed just as we have migrated to Melbourne. By performing these dances here in Naarm, they bring the history and tradition of Andean cultures to the urban space.

Alphington Open Studios	Alphington Open Studios is a community-based art collaboration of individual Darebin artists who work together in order to showcase their work. Alphington Open Studios aims to encourage participation and social connection through art within the community. All work on display are for sale or members of the public can commission a special work.
Circus Nexus (formerly Westside Circus)	Circus Nexus (CN – formerly Westside Circus) is a unique not-for-profit organisation in Melbourne, dedicated to using creative approaches to grow the mental and physical health of young people and support the growth and diversity of the Melbourne circus sector. The group provides experiences that prepare young people from varied social, economic and cultural backgrounds for an unknowable future by building their creative, emotional and physical literacy.
Crow Youth Boxing Program	The boxing program is a culturally safe space for Indigenous youth to come together and participate in positive activities. Although the program was started as an Indigenous-specific program, it welcomes all youth from any cultural background as we see it as an opportunity to prevent conflict and violence between groups of youth from different cultures as it is an issue among the youth in Darebin at present. The program is also promoting healthy lifestyle choices.
Croxton Community Garden Inc.	Croxton Community Garden is a volunteer organic community garden with 69 members. The group arose from a perceived need and deep desire for a community garden in our local area, which would enable the community to grow and have access to fresh and local organic fruit, vegetables and herbs. Garden members have constructed wicking beds for growing fruit and vegetables, installed irrigation pipes, created a composting area and have been surveyed about their interests going forward.
Croxton School	Croxton School is a government Prep to Year 12 specialist school in Northcote catering for students with an intellectual disability as their primary disability. It provides a safe and supportive learning environment where students are challenged to achieve and reach their full potential.
Darebin Climate Action Now	Darebin Climate Action Now (DCAN) is an independent community group of local citizens campaigning for a safe climate future. DCAN works actively across all areas of Darebin and seeks to be inclusive in all work to educate and inform local community members about the urgency of the climate crisis.
Darebin Ethnic Communities Council	The Darebin Ethnic Communities Council (DECC) is the peak body for ethnic communities within the Darebin municipality in the State of Victoria. DECC has advocated on behalf of and represented the views and interests of Darebin's culturally and linguistically diverse residents to all tiers of government for 30 years
Farmer Incubator Limited	Farmer Incubator is a small not-for-profit organisation that aims to grow conscious farmers in a way that empowers them with knowledge, experience, community and connection so that they can contribute to the respectful regeneration of land and the building of a sovereign food future. Their programs work to build pathways for new and aspiring farmers into the agricultural sector through establishing collaborative farming models and skill based training, lessening the many high cost and risk barriers to entry for new farmers.

The group organise regular hand weeding, litter pick-up and annual planting events to maintain and enhance habitat and biodiversity in the wetland and surrounds.
Global Gardens of Peace Inc.	Global Gardens of Peace is a non profit organisation based in Melbourne, which builds inclusive, accessible gardens, to inspire, heal and empower vulnerable communities. Global Gardens of Peace works with our partners to design sustainable landscapes that promote healing and wellbeing and have the capacity to change lives and make a positive impact.
Greek Women Traditional Dancing Group (Arhontises)	The group teaches traditional Greek dancing and performs voluntarily at aged care facilities, community and cultural events. The group enables women to exercise, socialise and share skills, language and knowledge about traditional Greek dancing and costumes. The general feedback from aged care facilities and cultural event organisers has been positive.
Ivan School Inc.	Ivan School - is a Russian Community Language School. Students enjoy language, grammar, spelling, reading games and participate in cultural celebrations. Most of the families who attend the school are new migrants and have difficulties with English. The school supports women and children with workshops, masterclasses, book fairs, and fitness sessions to keep people healthy and connected.
JOLT Sonic & Visual Arts Inc	JOLT Arts is an avant-garde sonic and arts org. that generates socially-engaged sonic and arts content, and then disseminates that content through: performances, community workshops, exhibitions, JOLT festivals, albums and other publications (writings/scores), online activity, and artist development. In 2022 JOLT is launching JOLTED, a new arts space and HQ at 342 High St Northcote, Victoria. JOLT has a 12-year track record of promoting and enabling career pathways for artists at all stages of their careers.
Macedonian Senior Citizen Group Prespa	The Prespa group is a group for senior members of the Macedonian community in the City of Darebin. The group has weekly meetings to socialise, build relationships(friendships) , celebrate language and culture, reduce the feeling of loneliness, isolation while improving our wellbeing(physically and mentally) Activities include card and board games, craft, morning tea and a luncheon once a month.
Melbourne Ice Wolves	Melbourne Ice Wolves are an Ice Hockey club that plays out of Reservoir and supports the Ice Hockey Pride Cup, to be held at IceHQ in Reservoir. Adopting LGBTIQ+ best practice inclusion guidelines as provided by Proud 2 Play engaging in inclusion education for internal members and facilitating inclusion education for the wider community for inclusion and diversity programs in the sport of ice hockey in Melbourne and the Darebin area.

Ms Janelle Johnstone	Sonic aGender is an event based collective promoting conversations about gender and music in Melbourne since 2018. The collective is led by local musician, producer and academic Janelle Johnstone who has over thirty years' experience in programming music venues and festivals in Melbourne, as well as extensive experience across the arts sector including community broadcasting, journalism, and community development.
Ms Samantha Harlow-Black	Sam Harlow-Black is a multimedia artist from Reservoir Melbourne. Her early work life began as a primary school and early childhood teacher before graduating with a Master of Arts (Art In Public Space) from RMIT on the Deans list in 2018. She has always been a fanatical creative person who started making art with knitting and crocheting as a child and now is working towards completing her Masters in Therapeutic Arts Practice at MIECAT in Fitzroy, Melbourne.

Together with cafes, offices, and retailers, we also keep soft plastic packaging out of landfill and our oceans, partnering with Victorian recyclers to create new products and close the loop on soft plastic.
Saluhan	Saluhan is an emerging Filipinx/o artist collective working across Bunurong and Wurundjeri Country in Naarm/Melbourne. Saluhan was founded in 2019 by artist Aida Azin as a network for creatives in Australia and the Philippines, and has since expanded to include workshops, events, and gatherings combining art and community development.
Speak Percussion	Speak Percussion has shaped the sound of 21st century Australian percussion music through the creation and presentation of ambitious arts projects.
