



GEOGRAPHIC NAMING PROPOSAL TO NAME THE NORTHCOTE AQUATIC AND RECREATION CENTRE, FAIRFIELD LIBRARY, NORTHCOTE LIBRARY, PRESTON LIBRARY, RESERVOIR LIBRARY AND THE PAVILION AT JOHN HALL RESERVE

Darebin City Council (Council) in its capacity as naming authority under the Geographical Place Names Act 1998 is intending to consider proposals to name:

- Northcote Aquatic and Recreation Centre at 180 Victoria Road, Northcote
- Fairfield Library at 121 Station Street, Fairfield
- Northcote Library at 32-38 Separation Street, Northcote
- Preston Library at 266 Gower Street, Preston
- Reservoir Library at 23 Edwardes Street, Reservoir
- The Pavilion at John Hall Reserve at John Hall Reserve, 188 Dunne Street, Bundoora
