**Background**

Building Regulations 92 requires that 'the report and consent of the relevant council must be obtained to an application for a building permit to construct a fence within 9 metres of a point of intersection of street alignments and exceeding a height of 1.0m above the footpath.'

**Application**

To apply for this special consent, the application to Council should include;

- (1) A covering letter stating the reason/s why the consent is requested.
- (2) A clear copy of the current 'Certificate of Title' identifying the allotment dimensions and the location of any easements.
- (3) Three copies of the proposed plans clearly indicating;
  - (a) the allotment dimensions and identification of the intersecting streets,
  - (b) the outline of any existing buildings on the allotment,
- (c) a plan and elevation drawing of the fence showing its location, size, and type of construction,
- (4) Evidence to show that an application for a building permit has been lodged.
- (5) Include neighbours comments.

**Assessment**

The application will be referred to Council's 'Transport Management & Planning Unit' for a 'line of site' safety evaluation.

**Determination**

A letter of decision will be mailed to the applicant, following full assessment of the application.
