

Different types of items may be collected on different days. Do not add items after your collection commences.

### Place in separate piles

- ✓ Electronic waste e.g. hair dryer, vacuum cleaner, TV, computer, CD player
- Scrap metal e.g. oven, washing machine, hot water system, dishwasher
- Car tyres (max. four, no truck or 4WD tyres)

### Accepted and may go to landfill



### Place in one pile

- Broken/damaged household furniture and goods
- ▼ Timber (up to 12 pieces, 1.5m in length, neatly stacked, no fence palings)
- Small glass items, crockery (glass must be secured in a box clearly marked 'glass')

### Not accepted. These items will not be collected.

- ❸ Hazardous waste e.g. asbestos, syringes, toilets
- Section Gas bottles, fire extinguishers
- S Fridges, freezers, air conditioning units
- Liquids e.g. chemicals, oil, paint, fertilisers
- Bean bags, polystyrene filling

- 8 Batteries of any type
- Car bodies, coil springs and car parts
- ⊗ Building, construction, renovation material (e.g. bricks, concrete, rubble, stone)
- Sarden waste e.g. tree prunings, soil

- Household garbage (e.g. nappies, food)
- 8 Household recycling
- Commercial, industrial, business waste
- Light globes and tubes


# Put your hard waste out for collection

Your household can:

 Place a maximum of one cubic metre of material (equal to two washing machines side by side) out for collection.

Any excess will not be collected.

Place these items in four separate piles so they can be recycled:



Place all other items in a neat, separate pile to be collected and sent to landfill.

- All item/s must be easily lifted by two people and no longer or wider than 1.5m.
- Do not place items out after 6am on the date listed on this brochure.
- Your items may not all be collected on the same day during your collection week, as separate trucks are used for different items. Items placed out late will not be collected.
