


The future is circular!

Business as usual -

STAGE

Business as usual but making an effort to:

- Learn about how the circular economy works
- Reduce waste by increasing efficiency
- Share, rent and use 'products-as-a-service' instead of buying
- Repair instead of replace equipment or fixtures
- Buy only durable products that can be maintained and upgraded
- Use recycled and recyclable products
- Separate waste and recycle appropriately

Start to transform your business by:

STAGE

- Continuing to advance all of the above
- Developing a detailed circular business plan, unique to your business. Consider training and/or engaging a consultant
- Researching case studies and discussing opportunities with your business community
- Rethinking your products / services to find circular alternatives
- Finding more ways to keep your resources at their highest value (reduce waste, including recycling)
- Networking to find circular partners to share resources or exchange waste materials

Implement transformation by:

STAGE

- Continuing to advance all of the above
- Finalising your circular business plan and starting implementation
- Influencing your supply chain to change - make it easier for others to follow
- Finding ways to regenerate natural resources
- Offering product stewardship programs and 'products-as-a-service'

- Constantly reviewing and updating your circular business plan
- Adjusting priorities to align with changing business needs and opportunities
