Since 2019, Darebin Council has proudly supported 130+ street parties, strengthening neighbourhood bonds and celebrating local communities together.

WHAT IS A STREET PARTY?

A street party is a friendly small-scale event designed to bring neighbours together in a relaxed community focused atmosphere. Key features include:

- Involves residents from a specific street
- Includes fewer than 150 local guests
- Requires a road closure of no more than 200 metres
- Non commercial and not open to general public
- Held as a single-day event
- Must finish by 9pm to respect neighbours

WHO CAN APPLY?

To apply for a street party, you must:

- Be a Darebin Resident
- Be at least 18 years old
- Live in a residential property
- Live on the street of the party
- Accept the Terms & Conditions

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO TO HOLD A STREET PARTY?

- Download the Neighbourhood Street Party Information Kit
- Review Kit to understand eligibility requirements and application process
- Get written consent from your neighbours
- Submit application forms
- On approval, notify emergency services
- Setup & cleanup of party



HOW DO WE SUPPORT YOUR STREET PARTY?

Council offers a range of incentives to help you hold your party:

- Free Public Liability Insurance
- Free traffic management plans for road closure
- Free traffic management plan assessment
- Free street party permit
- Free traffic management for up to 4hrs.
