



# DAREBIN WEED LIST



## Introduction

We've prepared the Darebin Weed List to help guide applicants preparing Landscape Plans to accompany Planning Permits for residential development. It has been extracted from the [Darebin Integrated Weed Management Strategy 2019-2023](#) which was developed as a resource for Darebin staff and community.

All the species listed in the weed list are of varying threat to wildlife habitat, native flora and fauna, including rare or threatened plants and must not be planted in Darebin.

The Darebin Parks and Gardens team have identified the following plants as comprising their 'top ten' priority weeds. The top two plants are two species of grass commonly used for lawns. Do not specify these lawn species in your landscape plans. Alternative lawn species should be used e.g. Buffalo (*Bouteloua dactyloides* and cultivars).
