

Plan your Visit


BUS Routes: 552, 553, 555, 556, 558, 561 Within a 3 minutes from stops to Intercultural Centre.

TRAIN Line: Mernda Line - Preston Station 6 minutes to the Intercultural Centre. Station has lifts from the platform to the street level.

TRAM: Stop 48 (Gower St/ Plenty Rd) approx 8 minutes Intercultural Centre.

CYCLE: Northern Pipe Trail/ St Georges Rd Path Short ride along Gower St to Intercultural Centre. On street bike parking available nearby.

Accessible Car Park: The access carpark location is marked with an orange arrow in the image below. Darebin Intercultural centre is located at 350 High Street, Preston, Victoria, 3072




Image description: **A map with the Darebin Intercultural Centres Location.** The centre is marked with a red pin, indicating its address at 350 High St, Preston VIC 3072.

Access Information

The Darebin Intercultural Centre has the following access features:

- DDA compliant ramps to entrance with handrails
- Braille & tactile signage displayed to identify each toilet and required exit
- Accessible toilets two are All Gender and one available in each Male and Female toilets
- Pictogram signage for bathroom
- Baby change facilities
- Kitchenette
- Prayer / reflection room
- Nearby: Changing Places bathroom (opposite Preston library) within library hrs

Assistance Animals are welcome.



Accessible Wheelchair All Gender Toilets

There are a total of 2 All Gender Wheelchair Accessible Toilets. The doors also open automatically by pressing the green button on the right. The all gender toilets are located to the left hand side of the foyer moving towards the entrance of the shire hall. There is also Braille and tactile signage to find the toilets.



Male and Female Wheelchair Accessible Toilets

There is a total of 1 wheelchair Accessible toilet in each of the Male and Female toilets. There is a change room available at the Preston Library located at 266 Gower Street Preston,3072. 2 to 3 minutes away from the Darebin Intercultural Center
