A total of 44 applications have been recommended for a small grant.

Organisation/ Group	Organisation/ Group Description
The Australian Catholic University (ACU) and the Order of Malta	The Australian Catholic University (ACU) and the Order of Malta are committed to a contribution to 'community development' with and within Darebin communities through outreach activities and partnerships through the Mobile Community Cafe initiative at the Reservoir Neighbourhood House and at the Agg Street public housing estate.
Australian Greek Ex-Servicemen Elderly Seniors Club of Northcote	This organisation helps Greek elderly community members connect weekly, with over 60 members. It benefits the members by creating relationships within the Greek culture and religion. It breaks isolation, loneliness and depression and creates a meeting place for them to connect and come together in friendship.
Blue Rhythm Arts Troupe	A community group of Chinese women, who provide a warm, supportive environment where members can feel a sense of belonging and cultural pride. It celebrates culture through dance, fashion, and community engagement weekly at the Reservoir East Senior Citizens Centre.
Brain Injury Matters North Metro Peer Support Group	Based in Northcote is one of nine peer groups across Victoria. It has weekly in-person meet-ups aimed at reducing social isolation and building skills, resilience, and connection. It also provides support for travel training, legal rights for people with ABI, Victorian health system and navigating changes to the NDIS.
Congee Social Club	A social and cultural space for the LGBTQIA+ Asian community to connect and celebrate their identity. Through sharing diverse cultural practices through food, art (visual, film, music, literature, games), knowledge shared, events, and exhibitions centred around shared cultural calendars such as Lunar New Year.
Croxtion Community Garden	Croxtion Community Garden is a volunteer organic community garden with 69 members. The group arose from a need and deep desire for a community garden in the Croxtion area, which would enable the community to grow and have access to fresh and local organic fruit, vegetables, and herbs.
Darebin Chess Club	Darebin Chess Club is a community organisation whose mission is to improve residents' educational outcomes and social development with the game of chess. Activities range from teaching and coaching programs; chess play both leisurely and competitively for all levels and all age groups.
East Preston and East Reservoir Community Action Group for Public Housing Residents	The group provides advocacy, resources, and support for public housing tenants. It advocates for public housing tenants and provides tenant advice and referrals to other services, including education and training, health, and legal services.
Fairfield Community Garden Inc.	Located in Alphington with plots for members to work, share produce & communal tasks to improve and maintain this special environment. The garden provides a safe, trusted environment for improved wellbeing and help reduce social isolation and increase accessibility to community members.
Fairfield Hellenic Seniors and Carers	A group of volunteers that supports isolated seniors living in Fairfield, Northcote, Thornbury, Alphington, and surrounds. It has a supportive network of Carers to meet the needs of a frailer ageing population and help them access a variety of information and activities that foster healthy living and social connection.

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Footscape Inc.	Established in 2009 Footscape is an Australian Podiatry charity that assists disadvantaged persons encountering debilitating foot problems. Organisation projects include Foot Care Kits: people seeking asylum, homeless persons, and First Nations persons. Provision of footwear and socks to disadvantaged population groups and provision of pro bono Podiatry clinical services.
Friends Of Regent Community Garden	Friends of Regent Community Garden have a space where the local community can connect, learn and participate in communal food gardening and sharing of fresh produce as well as provide sustainable activities including workshops and social events in a safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment.
Greek And Cypriot Social/Welfare Centre	The centre has a monthly variety of activities for members such as guest speakers, luncheons, outings, and a welfare service.
Greek Choir Parikia	The choir is made up of senior citizens from the Greek Australian community and some other CALD communities. The group rehearses once a week and performs across Darebin and other areas of Melbourne. This choir encourages social participation and reduces isolation for senior community members and promotes the Greek culture through music and socialising.
Greek Elderly Citizens of Thornbury	A community group of senior citizens and pensioners. It has been operating for several years and frequent every Tuesday at St George-Community Hall. It is located at 66 St David St, Thornbury. It offers hot meals, weekly activities, education seminars and other community functions that engages in senior community involvement.
Greek Women of Northern Suburbs 'Anemones'	The group was established to provide support and to enhance physical and mental wellbeing to women in the Northern Suburbs. The group provides members with the opportunity to meet weekly, dance and socialise and to stay connected with their community. Members voluntarily perform traditional Greek dancing at Aged Care facilities to entertain the residents and perform at multicultural concerts and other events.
Hellenic Women's Federation Victoria	The Hellenic Women's Federation of Victoria is a multi-cultural organisation centred around supporting the well-being of the Darebin community. The group plans events that cater for the diversities of the community, inclusive of people with special needs.
Home Away from Home Chinese Elders Group	Home Away from Home Chinese Elders Group meets at the East Reservoir Senior Citizens Centre. The group provides mutual support and wellbeing, access to information of services, programs and activities and to learn new skills like cooking, dancing, playing card, mahjong, Ping - Pong games etc.
Keon Park soccer club	Keon Park Soccer Club has been based in the City of Darebin for over 40 years. It has provided the opportunity for all genders to be active and involved within a local sports club. It has junior children, young adults, and adult participants. Most players come from Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds.
Macedonian Senior Citizen Group- Prespa	Prespa are a group for senior members of the Macedonian community in Darebin. The group has weekly meetings to socialise, build friendships, celebrate language and culture, reduce the feeling of loneliness, isolation while improving wellbeing. Activities include card and board games, craft, morning tea and a luncheon once a month.
Manna4life	Manna4Life has been operating in Darebin since 2021. It provides a weekly home cooked dinner on Thursday evenings for the underprivileged and homeless at the Reservoir Neighbourhood House.

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Melbourne Harmony Rhythm Beijing Opera Group	This non-profit organization is aimed at providing local Chinese communities with a place to enjoy and participate in traditional Beijing Opera. The organization endeavours to promote Beijing Opera to foster cultural exchange, diversity, and artistic expression. It also participates in annual Chinese opera events in Darebin and across the State of Victoria.
Melbourne Polytechnic Advanced Diploma Jewellery and Object Design	The Advanced Diploma of Jewellery and Object Design from the Fairfield Campus have annual exhibitions from the 2023 graduating class. This supports emerging artists in the community and unites the creative community, bringing together local artists, galleries, and professionals from the industry.
Multiethnic Senior Citizen -Preston	The group is mixture of elderly people from Bosnia and Herzegovina. They meet on a weekly basis at the Preston Library and the aim of this group is to help and prevent the isolation and loneliness of elderly people. They participate in regular socialization and networking between people who speak the same language, are of same culture and have similar lifestyle.
Nuba Omarang Association of Australia-Melbourne	A Sudanese group whose members come from the same community - Nuba Omarang. It meets twice a month with the aim of retaining cultural connections including language & traditional dance and to prepare for annual festivals.
Ne African Women's and Children Support Group	A community group promoting African-based intercultural social events open to all women. It supports the welfare of African women and children based in East Preston/Reservoir, through activities such as Homework Club & intercultural women's exercise groups. Activities are based at East Preston Community Centre.
Northcote Baptist Church	The church community provides much needed spiritual and emotional resources to our diverse community. It has an English & Chinese speaking community which focuses on people from all nations including many with CALD backgrounds.
Northcote Swimming and Lifesaving Club	A community-based club, providing coaching and training programs for swimmers of all abilities to develop the skills, strength and fitness and pathways toward competitive swimming. NTC has training programs to meet the needs of swimmers of varying abilities and welcomes swimmers with a disability.
Northern and Inner Multiple Birth Association	Northern and Inner Multiple Birth Association (NIMBA) is run by local volunteer parents who provide support, assistance, and social connection to other families of multiples (twins, triplets and higher order births). NIMBA has 43 families (180 residents) residing in Darebin.
Northern Region Indian Seniors Association (NRISA)	This association comprises of seniors from diverse cultures, but mostly from a common Indian background. It strives to address the issues of loneliness among our members and provides opportunities for socialising, share information about Darebin services and Indian cultural music, dance, food, and drink.
Pinko Collective	Pinko Collective is an intergenerational music collective that aims to strengthen community connections to celebrate creativity and collaboration. It provides a range of services and supports to ensure musicians can perform their best.
Preston Cricket Club Inc	Preston Cricket Club have been a part of the Preston/Darebin landscape for 160 years, acting as a senior cricket body and arranging a variety of junior & senior programs for boys and girls. This includes get active programs and Winter Academy for boys and girls free of charge.

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Preston Lions Football Club	Preston Lions Football Club has been a cornerstone of the local community, fostering inclusivity, youth development, structured training programs, mentoring, and skill development. It also nurtures young talent, teamwork, respect, and resilience.
Preston Boxing Youth Club	The Preston Boxing and Youth Club is a youth centre aimed at physical fitness and general well-being for over 60 years. It welcomes young participants from all abilities and backgrounds including Indigenous youth, drug and alcohol affected members of society, immigrants and people of all religious backgrounds.
Preston Garden Club	A local nonprofit community group since 1934. It has monthly meetings with guest speakers, produces a monthly Newsletter, organizes garden visits, and holds monthly guest speakers and competitions for members to learn more about gardening and to share stories and expertise with each other.
Probus Club of Kingsbury	The group encourages lifestyle, health, and wellbeing for semi-retired/retired members of the community. It provides a variety of activities including day trips, theatre outings and Guest Speakers.
Reach Community Church	Reach engages the community with information of activities/clubs etc in their local municipality to support engaging children and families, improve mental & physical health and connect with others in the community.
Reservoir Chinese Seniors' Group	All members are Chinese senior citizens aged 60+ from different areas of China. The group meets to share traditional Chinese culture and participate in activities such as singing, tai chi, cooking, and tours of Melbourne.

Thornbury Church of Christ	Food Relief Program endeavours not only to provide essential food, bakery and grocery items to assist everyday cost of living, but a safe and comfortable space to 'be'; play cards, chat, enjoy a meal, snack and or hot beverage amongst both members of the community and the Food Relief team.

Her multidisciplinary practice is centred around protecting and celebrating Country. Gamelan DanAnda	Gamelan DanAnda (GDA) is a Balinese gamelan percussion orchestra based in Darebin, Naarm. GDA regularly perform at Australia's leading festivals including Oz Asia Festival, Brunswick Music Festival, AsiaTOPA, the National Folk Festival, Port Fairy Folk Festival and more. Recent collaborations have been with Joelistics, Balinese Australian neo-soul singer/producer Komang, and electro-jazz-fusion band Firetail.
JOLT Sonic & Visual Arts	JOLT Arts is an avant-garde sonic and arts org. that generates socially engaged sonic and arts content, and then disseminates that content through performances, community workshops, exhibitions, JOLT festivals, albums, and other publications (writings/scores), online activity, and artist development.
